Tufi is a small town located in a remote, pristine region of Papua New Guinea at the tip of Cape Nelson in Oro Province. Tufi has been described as the "Scandinavia of the tropics". The breath-taking "fjords", locally known as rhias, were not carved out by icy glaciers but created by the ancient eruption of 3 volcanoes. They plunge to over 90 metres and rise over 150 metres vertically above the water. The scenery is simply spectacular! There are numerous coastal villages open to visitors, providing peaceful backdrops to relax in between dives.



Tufi resort amenities include a terraced BBQ area; in-ground pool with views of the fjord below; table tennis and pool; lounge bar area and library. The main building is of a colonial design with a comfortable large surrounding, cool breezeways and natural lighting. Internally there is reception, gift shop, library, TV, lounge and dining area. Tufi offers incredible marine diversity and a variety of diving experiences including rhias, reef and wreck diving. The shallow water near the wharf has some fantastic critter subjects, allowing for great photoshoots. The tremendous variety of life includes; gobies, nudibranch, mandarin fish, ghost pipefish, pygmy seahorses, shrimps, clams, and many other fascinating critters. Pelagics such as dog fin tuna, turtles and manta rays are also reported sightings.



A 20-50 minute boat ride brings you to a string of reefs with bommies coming up from a depth of 50 to 600m, to a safe diving level of 7m. Visibility exceeds 30m with average year-round. There's an abundance of marine life including reef fish, barracuda, Spanish mackerel tuna, white tip and blacktip reef sharks and the rare white hammerhead. Mantas, eagle rays and turtles are often seen here too.

The majority of reefs in the region remain unexplored and it will be some time before the full diversity of the Tufi reefs is known. The resort focuses on reef and muck diving and all diving is carried out under the guidance of PADI dive professionals.



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
